We suggest printing out the list for the grade you will be in on September 7, 2011.

All students entering grades four through eight are required to read one book. Please make sure that you choose one book from the grade level you will be in on September 7, 2011. In addition, you will be writing a book review on the second or third day of school in September. Included on-line is a graphic organizer for you to print out and fill in as you read. Print out the appropriate grade-level graphic organizer. It will help you to remember details. Please NOTE: The organizer for grades 4 & 5 is appropriate for that level student. A different organizer is available for grades 6,7, & 8.

Bring your completed organizer to school on the first day. If you have any questions, ask your current teacher.
