

BOARD SELF-EVALUATION

The Board of Education is committed to the belief that every part of the school system in this district should be accountable to the public that supports that system and that performance evaluation is essential to that accountability. The Board further believes that the improvement and growth of any institution depend upon an honest appraisal of its strengths and weaknesses. The Board accepts, therefore, responsibility for the conduct of a systematic program of self-evaluation and appraisal. The standards against which the Board shall evaluate itself will be the educational goals, bylaws, and policies duly adopted by this Board.

The board shall use a multifaceted self-evaluation instrument.
