What We Learned

EMERGING AS READERS

Students learned the letters **n** and **i** and practiced our new heart words **is, as, little, and to**. We explored *whiney a* and the nasal sounds **an** and **am**.

Students are learning to blend CVC words and are beginning to read simple sentences!

NUMBERS THROUGH 9

The students enjoyed activities that allowed them compose and decompose numbers through 9 and compare sets of objects, identifying the set with greater/fewer.
