Decoding Fluency

- Consonant vowel consonant consonant words ex: puff, hiss, sent
- Consonant, consonant vowel consonant words: flag, slim, fled,

Word Fluency

- Heart words (see attached)
- Decoding or reading without decoding.

Reading

- Applying phonetic skills within texts accurately and fluently, with understanding.

Comprehension/Communication

- Tell about an event, a story, movie, book with relevant vocabulary and in order.

Writing

- Using illustrations, labels, and sentences with correct mechanics to communicate ideas and experiences.

Number Sense

- Counting forward and back; comparing values with respective terminology.

Money

- Identifying common coins, values, and using skip counting to find values of sets of coins.
