REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT:

Mr. Hurley brought the Board up to speed on recent district events, including the Tournament of Bands event hosted by the Rutherford High School Marching Band, Homecoming Weekend, the Distinguished Graduate ceremony, the selection of five Pierrepont students to the County Choir, the milestone reached by Jessica Rogers of the Rutherford High School Girls' Volleyball team by achieving 1,000 kills, and the progress made in the current marking period.

He further noted that the Board is being asked tonight to approve the plan to establish an upper elementary school at Pierrepont and a middle school at Union, effective September 2016. The plan has been discussed in detail in numerous public sessions over the past few months, including Board meetings, and will provide substantial benefits to students throughout the district. If the plan is approved tonight, the administration will begin to plan the implementation immediately, which will include addressing transportation and transition concerns.

He reported that he is recently in receipt of the long-awaited proposal for the development of an in-district Preschool program, and will be reporting on it to the relevant committees and to the full Board in November.
