Welcome to the Rutherford High School Bulldog Band!

What is expected of you- Marching Band is a very special and unique experience that we are we are able to provide to the students of RHS. It requires a high level of musicianship, teamwork, responsibility and discipline. It is also a very unique activity that does require a fairly high degree of physical activity. It is expected that students prepare themselves mentally and physically for the demands of the activity.

A positive attitude is a must. As long as the member gives 100% effort he/she will improve their skills and become a cherished member of the band/guard. The members of the band/guard will never be knowingly asked to do something that they cannot do or that will put them in harms way. In return we ask that members follow instruction and strive to improve every day.

As long as this trust is maintained between the staff and members, marching band will become a wonderful and fulfilling experience for all involved!

- Every member of the Marching Band and Color Guard MUST have a physical before they will be allowed to practice; this is school policy.
- Practice is held two evenings a week from 5:30-8:00pm (Tues/Thurs) until championships
- Most Fridays & Saturdays in Sept Nov we have football games and competitions that run into the late evening, these are mandatory. We have a college visit weekend infused in the schedule so please plan accordingly.
- Attendance at all rehearsals and performances are mandatory. Three unexcused absences will result in the member's removal from the group for the remainder of the season, no exceptions.

Physicals All members of the Marching Band and Color Guard need to have a physical. There are two ways to get a physical. One way is by the school doctor (This means free to you). 8th grade physicals will be held on Thursday June 9th from 3-4:00pm in the RHS Nurses office. All forms must be filled out before the physical. Current HS Student Marching Band Physicals will be held of June 15th in the nurses office at 1:30 pm.

Please contact the athletic office 201 438 7675 if you need more information. The physical forms are included with this packet. You and your parents must both sign this form. Second, you may go to your personal physician instead. If you choose to go to your own physician **that expense is borne by you, not the school**. If you don't get a physical you cannot practice or attend Band Camp, so be sure to get this done well before camp.

<u>Other Sports</u> You can do Marching Band and other sports during the fall season! We will be rehearsing primarily in the evening so there will not be a time conflict. I have a very good relationship with the athletic department so any conflicts that do arise can be resolved easily. Please contact me with any and all sports conflict concerns.

Band Camp

One of the most important events during the fall season is BAND CAMP. This year it will be held at Rutherford High School from Monday, August 29th through Friday, Sept 2nd from 8:30am-9pm (8:30am-3:30 on Friday). There is a small fee of \$40.00 to cover food, paper goods, and drinks for the entire fall season. If you join you will receive a list of what you need for band camp but the following three are very important. Please wear a hat, sunscreen, and athletic sneakers.

<u>No Sandals</u>. Please reference the band camp schedule and information sheet in this handbook for any more information or contact Mr. Kinne.

Uniform

You will be asked to sign a uniform contract and are required to follow all of the rules of maintaining the uniform set forth in the contract. In addition to the uniform all members are required to purchase marching shoes if they have not already done so. The cost is usually around \$30.00. This is handled in September. In all situations, if finances are ever an issue, please discuss the matter privately with Mr. Kinne. All issues will remain confidential and will be resolved accordingly. The band will never turn away a member for financial difficulties.

Performance Days

I will announce the time we are to meet on performance days as far in advance as possible. Please refer to the website for and up to date calendar. We travel on school and charter buses throughout the season. Students are responsible for transportation to and from the RHS for home games. In case of inclement weather DO NOT ASSUME CANCELLATION UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES, always check the calendar on the band website.

All About Band Camp

The term "Band Camp" has been popularized in movies and media in many ways. Unfortunately, most portrayals have been negative and false. Band Camp is really a session of intense practice lasting over a consecutive number of days usually no longer then a week. Band Camp is essential to a successful season in many ways:

If you look to the Camp Schedule you will see that our days are mix of hard work and fun! Please also note that food is not always provided so students are responsible for Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner. Band Camp also takes place in August where the temperature can vary greatly. Please be prepared for all weather and conditions. We will be outside as much as possible. Athletic Sneakers, Sunscreen and a Hat are mandatory items that must be worn on the field.

Some students, especially freshmen, can feel a bit overwhelmed at camp. This is very normal. Freshmen are the most important members of the band in that their dedication and determination are what gauge the success of the group. A lot is asked of our newest members in a short amount of time. The key to success in this group is that a new student <u>Must Never Give up!</u> As long as they give 100% and stick it out they WILL be great! It just takes time. Everyone in the band was new at some point and no one has ever been great at it right away.
