The acquisition of the new uniforms is the result of countless hours of work and the support of the parents, administrators and the board of education. These uniforms are of the highest quality and with proper care will last many years. The wearing of this uniform is a privilege and with that privilege comes the responsibility of proper care and respect. The same pride with which we enter the competition field or the concert stage needs to be reflected in the care and respect given the uniform. A note of warning: While I'm confident that most will automatically care for the uniform properly, anyone who does not, will quickly lose the privilege of wearing it.

Replacement costs for individual parts of the uniform is very expensive. Should you damage or lose any portion of the uniform you will be required to replace it at the current list cost. Updated costs for each item will be supplied annually by the manufacturer, and forwarded to you upon request.

REMARKS:

WEARER'S RESPONSIBILITY: *Our uniforms will be housed at RHS but please read anyway.*

- 1) Read and understand the complete user care responsibilities contained herein and on the care label inside each uniform garment piece.
- 2) Do not wash the uniform garment. Professional dry clean only.
- 3) Do not hand clean in any manner. Professional dry clean only.
- 4) Do not tumble dry or heat in any manner, such as hand ironing, blow drying, or over a hot stove, a wet uniform garment piece. Hang properly and allow to air dry at ambient conditions. Follow up promptly after air drying with requisite dry cleaning and/or pressing.
- 5) Do not contact uniform garment (for purpose of modifying conditions surrounding use of the garment) with:
 - a) antistats
 - b) water/oil proofers
 - c) spot cleaning chemicals
 - d) other topical chemicals such as: bleaches, spray deodorants, perfumes, brighteners, facial make ups, etc.
- 6) Examine the uniform garment after each use for soiling, stains, etc.
- 7) Abnormally stained uniform garments should be cleaned as soon as possible after the staining occurs by the approved professional dry cleaner. Do not attempt to hand clean.
- 8) Do not store uniform garment wet. Follow up as in B4, above.
- 9) Do not store stained uniform garment for long periods of time such as at the end of the current band use season until next band use season. TIME TENDS TO SET STAINS.
- 10) Examine the uniform garment before dry cleaning and identify location and type of stain (if possible) to the dry cleaner on delivery of the garment for cleaning.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT HAND PRESS ANY PORTION OF THE UNIFORM. PROFESSIONALLY PRESS ONLY. A HOT IRON WILL LEAVE A SHINE ON THE WOOL MATERIAL. IN AN EMERGENCY AND FOR LIGHT TOUCH UP THE CAREFUL USE OF A PRESSING CLOTH IS PERMISSIBLE. THE ONLY ALTERATION PERMISSIBLE IS THE ADJUSTMENT OF THE TROUSER LENGTH. THIS WILL BE ACCOMPLISHED BY DETACHING THE BIAS TAPE AND REATTACHING AT THE APPROPRIATE PLACE WITH A LIGHT BASTING STITCH. NO OTHER ALTERATION SHALL BE MADE WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF THE BAND DIRECTOR. IN AS MUCH AS THE UNIFORM JACKET IS WHITE NO FOOD OR DRINK WITH THE EXCEPTION OF WATER SHALL BE CONSUMED WHILE WEARING THE UNIFORM.

NEW UNIFORM WEARING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) HAT - STRAIGHT BRIM AT EYEBROWS
- 2) NO OBVIOUS MAKE-UP
- 3) NO HAIR TOUCHING COLLAR (CUT OFF OR PUT UP)
- 4) NO JEWELRY
- 5) NO NAIL POLISH
- 6) PANT LENGTH - JUST TOUCHING SHOE (NO BREAK)
- 7) BLACK SOCKS and proper clothes under uniform. RHS T- Shirt and form fitting pants. (No jeans under uniform ETC.)
- 8) POLISHED BAND SHOES
- 9) **THERE WILL BE NO EATING OR DRINKING IN UNIFORM with the exception of water.**
