Union Middle School Code of Conduct

The following consequences are subject to change. Administration may escalate disciplinary assignments at any level based upon the severity of the offense. A progressive discipline approach is taken within each school building and across the district, K-12. There could be an escalation to disciplinary assignments, which should alert parents and the student to address behaviors before they become even more serious. Generally, but not always, this progression could be as follows:

- 1. Warnings, **(TD)** teacher assigned detentions, and other creative resolutions.
- 2. **(LD)** Lunch Detention(s), and **(CD)** Central Detention(s) generally served within 24/48 hours of the offense.
- 3. (ISS) In-School Suspension, is suspension in school.
- 4. **(OSS)** Out-of School Suspension is an assigned day or days when a student is not permitted to attend school and his/her parents are responsible for them at this time.

Due to Federal student privacy rights under FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act) the school administration, faculty and staff cannot discuss the consequences or punishments of students other than your own.
