I'd also like to remind you that when the Health Department staff conducts contact tracing, a person can expect a thorough interview that takes 30-45 minutes. They will be asked questions including, but not limited to, their general demographic information (age, sex, etc), household situation, if they are exhibiting symptoms, their activities for the past 14 days and whether they will have access to food and medication if they are in quarantine. The benefits of keeping our schools and community open far outweigh any inconveniences an individual may experience by cooperating with the Health Department.
