WHAT IS SEA?

Students will be involved in thematic units centered around a high interest topic. Teachers will integrate math, science, social studies, and language arts throughout the unit of study. Students will get to explore, delve deep into topics, and use their creativity to share what is learned. The goal is to get the children excited about learning, use higher level thinking skills, foster creativity, and have fun with friends. Students will also have opportunity to acclimate themselves to Pierrepont School for a smoother transition in September.

WHO CAN ATTEND THE PROGRAM?

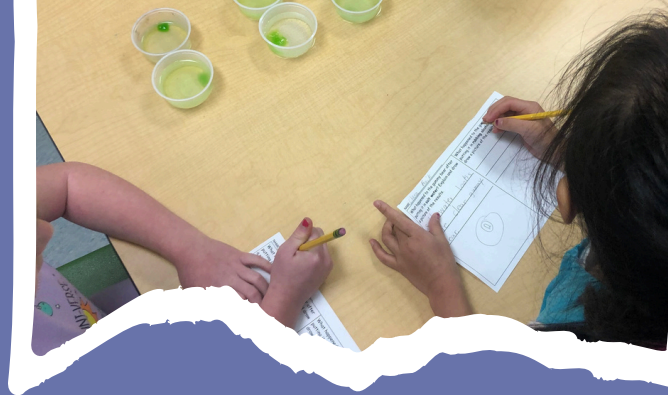
The SEA for **4th grade** is open to students registered in the Rutherford Public Schools who will be entering 4th grade in September 2025. Space is limited and on a first come, first served basis.

WHO WILL TEACH?

The children will be taught by professional staff members who have experience in the primary grades. There will also be a nurse on staff.

WHERE WILL THE PROGRAM BE HELD?

The program for 4th grade will be at **Pierrepont School**, located at 70 E. Pierrepont Avenue in Rutherford. Door #7 (Lincoln Avenue)



WHAT KINDS OF ACTIVITIES WILL BE OFFERED?

Students will be engaged in thematic units that integrate reading, writing, math, science, social studies, art, and technology. Projects will be problem-based and hands-on. Each thematic unit will culminate with a showcase of student learning.

WHAT IS THE SCHEDULE?

This year the program is scheduled to run from Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. beginning on Monday, July 7, 2025, and ending on Thursday, July 31, 2025.

WHAT IS THE FEE?

There is a \$475 fee for the program.

Before Care:

Parents who wish to drop off their children at 8:00 a.m. may do so. An additional fee of \$100 for early morning childcare for all of the days of the SEA program must be paid at registration.

WILL AFTERCARE BE PROVIDED?

No aftercare is provided through the SEA Program; however, the Rutherford Recreation Dept. runs a Summer Day Camp for a SEPARATE fee. More information can be found on the Rutherford Recreation website (rutherfordboronj.com) 4th grade Rec Camp students will be escorted to the designated camp area inside Pierrepont School.

HOW CAN I REGISTER?

Complete the registration form, which can be found on the Summer Program website <https://sites.google.com/rutherfordschools.org/summerprogramsitesite/registration>.

Registration begins April 1, 2025. The registration deadline is April 30, 2025.

HOW DO I PAY?

Tuition will be paid online utilizing Pay Schools . Transaction fees will be added based on payment method: ACH (checking account) \$1.75/ICF (credit card) 3.95%. Once the registration form is completed, tuition will be assigned to your Pay Schools account. Registration will not be complete until payment is received.
